- Approx. EUR 3 billion in annual procurements and investments

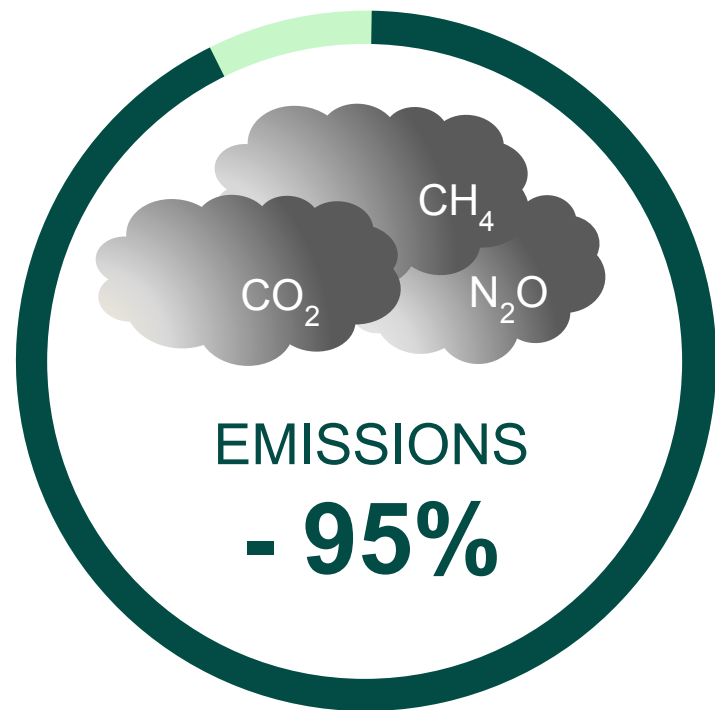




# City of Oslo uses procurements to reach sustainability goals

# Sub targets for the mobility sector

2020

Fossil free construction sites, public transport, heating/district heating.

Fossil free/zero emission criterias in tenders.

2025

Zero emission construction sites

Zero emission or biogas in transportation of goods/services

2028

Zero emission public transport, including busses and passenger ferries



# Achieved so far

- First zero emission construction site in the world
- Electric ferries commuting to neighbouring municipality
- 72% of the city's own vehicle fleet is zero emission
- Several goods and service contracts with zero emission deliveries
- Fossil fuel use in our own activities (transport, construction, heating) reduced by ~80% since 2012.

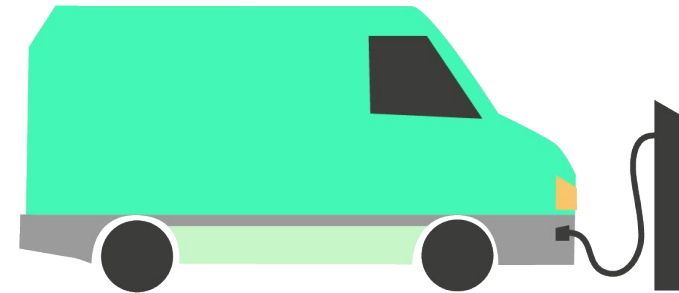


# Last-mile transport in contracts

Coffee machines and water coolers	100%	
Servers	100%	
Mobile phones	100%	
Lamps, light bulbs and equipment	100%	
ICT equipment (computers and screens)	100%	
Medical consumables and equipment	100%	
Charging stations for electric cars	100%	
iPad and Mac products	100%	
Cleaning products, paper, plastic and disposable products	90%	10%
Office supplies	67%	33%
Fruits and vegetables	20%	60%
